Farm Gleaning with The St Lucy Project

Commissioned by Christ (www.commissionedbychrist.org) is joining Catholic Charities of Arlington's St. Lucy Project (<https://www.ccda.net/need-help/food/>) to glean crops at Parker Farms on the northern neck of Virginia through a series of One Day Mission trips. These one-day farm gleaning mission trips are great family events, an opportunity to help feed the hungry (a corporal work of mercy), and a great service project for church groups, bible studies, book clubs and confirmation students.
