### The Angel Tree

The Christmas season is upon us and with it an opportunity to share our blessings with others less fortunate. As we've done in years past, we will collect both food and gifts for families in the area. This year there are 8 families that our church has "adopted". The Angel Tree and food suggestions will be setup in the gathering area. Gifts should be wrapped with the angel attached (for multiple packages – simply make additional tags with the information taken from the angel eg. Red angel 1C) this will ensure each gift finds its way to the person for whom it is intended.

Food and (wrapped) gifts need to be returned on or before December 12<sup>th</sup> to allow time to prepare for delivery. Angels are removed and replaced with the name of the recipient. Food is sorted, packaged with a turkey and delivered with our gifts. If your family would like to make another's Christmas a little brighter by providing food &/or gift(s), select one or more angels from the Angel Tree and pick up a food suggestion list. As in past years, any surplus food is donated to the Orange Food Pantry.

If you participate, please, please, - don't forget to write your contact information next to the number/letter of the angel you've taken on the angel sign out sheet provided. The gifts collected are intended for specific individuals so we really need to keep track of everyone. If it is not signed out, we must assume it was lost.
