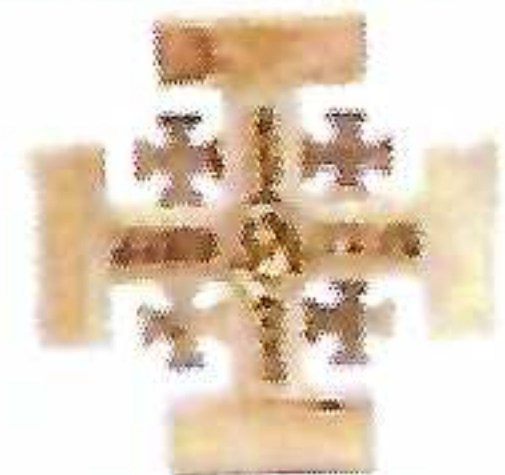
Women's Seeking Jesus in Lent in Women's Silent Retreat
