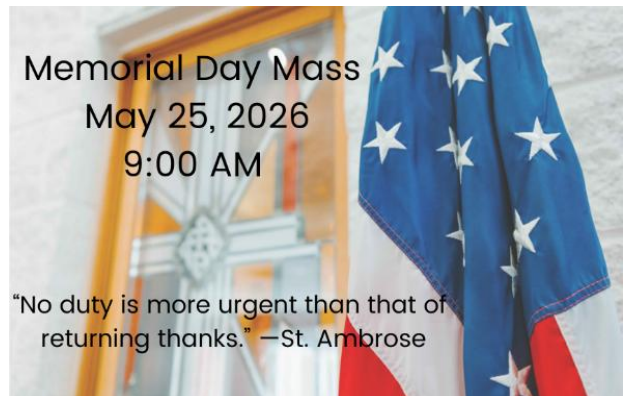
**St Isidore New Business Manager**

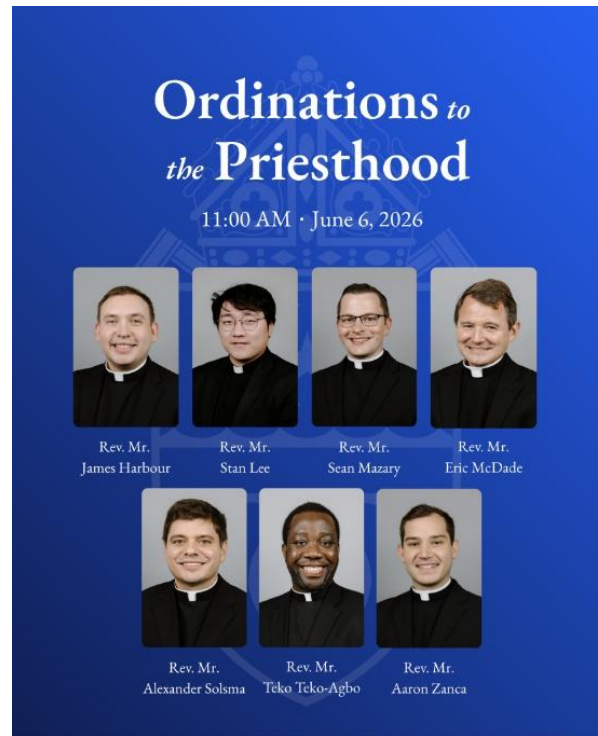

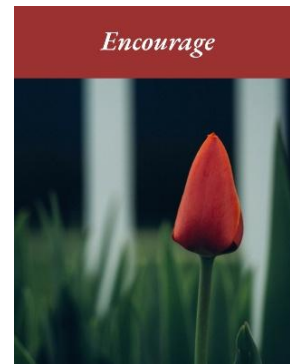
