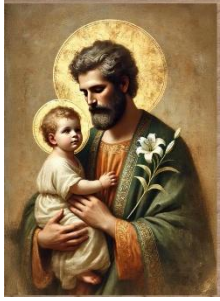

In the upcoming election on November 3, Virginia voters will be asked to amend the state constitution to enshrine as a "fundamental right". The proposed amendment would remove virtually all restrictions on abortion, compromise parental rights, and strip away the born alive of the right to medical care after a failed abortion. As faithful Catholics, we are obligated to educate ourselves on the issues and vote in accordance with a conscience informed by Church teaching. 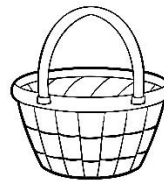

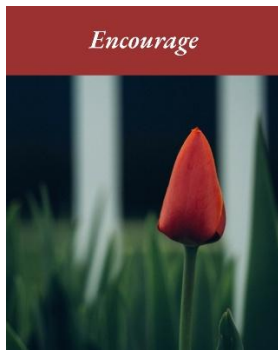
