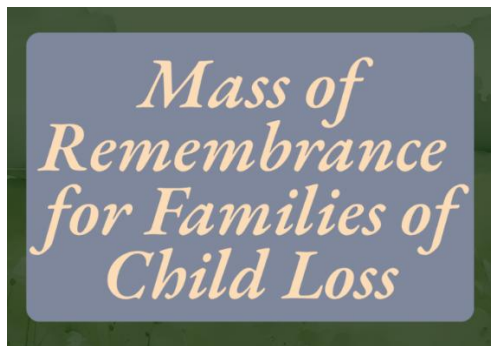
CALLED: A Conference for Young Adults

Faith and Science: From Wonder to Human Genius

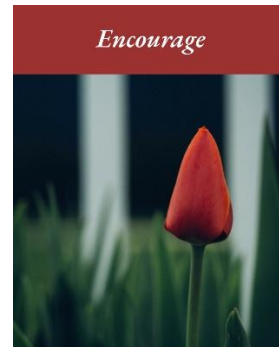


Christendom College invites you to a weekend of intellectual renewal at this year's summer conference, "Faith and Science: From Wonder to Human Genius." Leading Catholic
