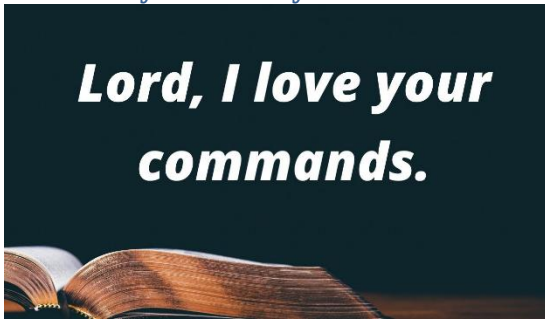

Faith and Science: From Wonder to Human Genius



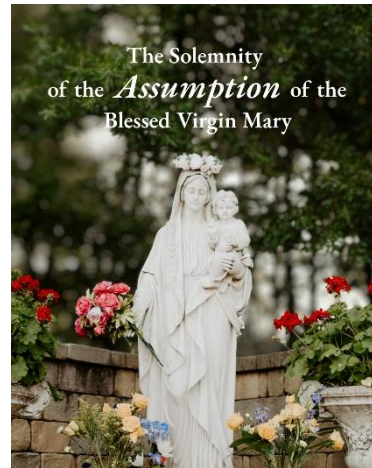
