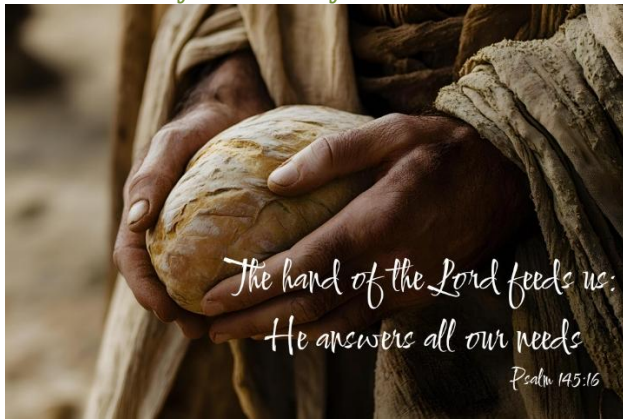

In honor of the Franciscan Jubilee Year, the Franciscan Sisters of the

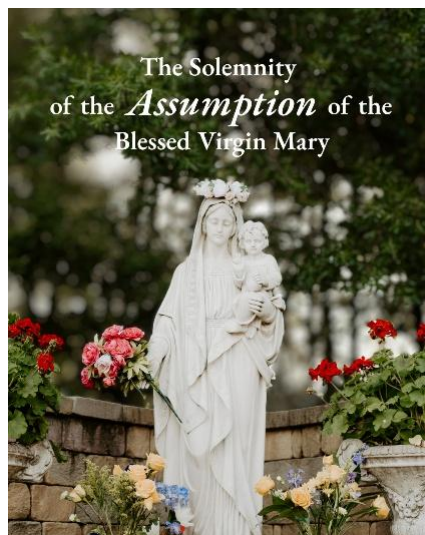
